



### LCA Elementary FAQ:

- **How many students are in a typical class?**  
The typical class size is less than 18 students.
- **What is the curriculum that we use in our elementary classes?**  
Bob Jones for reading, phonics, language arts, math, science, and history. ACSI for Bible.
- **What testing tool do we use during the admissions process/and spring testing?**  
We use the Terra Nova survey for our admissions testing for grades 2<sup>nd</sup>- 12<sup>th</sup>. We also use the Terra Nova full battery for spring testing.
- **Are our teachers certified?**  
Yes, they are certified by the state and through the Assoc. of Christian Schools International.
- **Do we have organized sports/fine arts programs for elementary students?**  
No, we encourage families to participate in local churches that have sports programs, such as Upward and I9 programs.
- **Do we have volunteer opportunities? What are they? How do we sign up?**  
Yes, we love volunteers! Our parent association (LCAPA) has a list of all of the opportunities to serve that they email out to our families.
- **Do we foresee moving to a new campus or building our own campus in the future?**  
YES!! We just purchased 10 acres and had another 24 acres, adjacent to the purchased property, donated to LCA! We will be located right next to CMC in Flowery Branch, GA.
- **Are we affiliated with Chestnut Mountain Church?**  
No, we only lease space from them. We are non-denominational.
- **What fundraisers will we have?**  
Walk of Faith in the fall and our LCA Spring event in the spring.
- **When do we have chapel?**  
We have chapel on Wednesdays. Students do not have a "chapel" uniform.
- **What do we expect from parents when a child returns to school after being out?**  
They should plan with the teacher prior to being out so that the student does not fall behind. Please provide a dr. note upon returning to school.
- **Can a student miss more than the 6 allowed absences?**  
We ask that parents make plans for vacations during our breaks, but we do understand that emergencies happen. Please be in contact with the principal and your student's teachers.
- **Can uniforms be purchased from anyone other than the Target Group?**  
We ask that all uniforms be purchased from The Target Group. They offer a wide variety of options.
- **For the UM, how do parents contact their teacher on Tues/Thurs. if they have a question?**  
The teacher will share how to contact them on your home school days.
- **What safety measures do we have in place on our campus?**  
We have the following in place: 28 security cameras on our campus, every visitor must sign in and have visitors tag, and we have a security officer on campus all day.  
**Zero Tolerance for Bullying at LCA:** Our faculty and the administration will work together to promote Christ-like behavior and provide in-class practice with our campus counselor on how to have healthy relationships.



## **FAQ FOR LCA UPPER SCHOOL (Grades 6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>):**

- **What is the typical class size for upper school?**  
The typical class size is less than 20 students.
- **What curriculum do we use?**  
We use a variety of curricula. All curriculum is taught from a Biblical worldview.
- **Do we offer AP and/or Dual Enrollment classes?**  
Yes, we do offer both AP classes for 10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> and Dual Enrollment classes for our 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>-grade students.
- **Do we have digital devices that our high school students use? What is the device?**  
Yes, we are using Google classroom and we have Google Chromebooks that are used in our classrooms.
- **Can they bring their own device from home to work on assignments/take notes?**  
Only with the teacher's permission.
- **What are our rules about cell phones?**  
Cell phones are to be turned off and put away. They can only use their cell phone with the teacher's permission.
- **What sports do we have?**  
Fall: volleyball, football, cross country, cheerleading  
Winter: basketball, cheer, and swim team  
Spring: soccer for guys/girls, co-ed tennis, co-ed golf, softball, and baseball
- **What fine art opportunities do we have?**  
We have choir, art, digital art, and drama
- **What colleges do our graduates get accepted to?**  
There is a listing in our student profile in the admissions folder.
- **What does the typical LCA graduate do after high school?**  
The majority of our seniors will be attending the college of their choice.
- **Can a middle school student earn high school credits? What opportunities do they have to earn high school credits?**  
They can earn high school credit in 8<sup>th</sup> grade in Personal Fitness, and Algebra I.
- **Do we have an SAT prep class?**  
Yes, we do, for high school students.
- **Do high school students get to visit colleges that are organized through the school?**  
Yes, they have fall and spring trips planned for our high school students. We also have a spring college fair on our campus for 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> students and their parents.
- **Are the UM and TM in classes together and when do they interact?**  
They are not together for core classes. They are mixed during elective classes, at lunch, in chapel, and in extracurricular activities (fine arts and athletic programs). Some upper-level classes are comprised of both models.
- **How many classes can an LCA Choice student take?**  
LCA choice students can take up to 4 classes each semester.
- **PSAT/SAT/ACT testing?** Yes, we do offer testing on our campus.
